OUR HISTORY

In 1921 Michele Testa, Sr. arrived in Palm Beach from Chicago, Illinois. He opened a small soda fountain shop with seven seats and a few small tables in the old Garden Theater, and that was the beginning of our family restaurant. His timing was right. It was in this same era that Henry Morrison Flagler, founder of Standard Oil, helped turn the Atlantic coast of Florida into a destination for sun-seekers. Soon the first of several million guests found their way to Testa's.

Since those early days the restaurant has been a driving force for our family. It is not just a way to earn a living, but is central to our lives. The Palm Beach community is extended family to us. We've shared great times together, raised our families together, and fought side-by-side during the storms and fires which have touched our area.

For over three quarters of a century Testa's has been part of Palm Beach life. These years are reflected in the photographs in our family scrapbook, which is on display in the dining room. We invite old friends and new to look through its pages and a long and rich history.

The restaurant is still owned and run by the Testa family, along with a sister restaurant in Bar Harbor, Maine.
